SUMMARY

This is a machinist position with 4 years minimum experience in machining operations.

Candidate must be able to use appropriate equipment such as Turning and Milling machines to create machined parts to match drawings. Use the proper equipment to machine angles, radii, slots, holes, etc. on all tooling to create high quality, tight tolerance parts. These duties are to be performed within quality standards.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Read blueprints to determine material dimensions, required equipment, and operations sequences.
- Do all machine and tooling setup as required.
- Program CNC control at machine to achieve desired results.
- Performs dimensional inspection of machined parts as required.
- Monitor and change cutting tools as needed.
- Loads and unloads machined.
- Lay out and mark reference points and dimensions on materials, using measuring instruments.
- Rework or alter parts and components as required to ensure that products meet standards.

- Ability to organize work assignments to ensure efficient operations.
- Critical thinking – Using logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems.
